



LANGWARRIN FOOTBALL NETBALL CLUB NETBALL PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

As a person representing Langwarrin Football Netball Club as a netball player, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during an activity held or sanctioned by the Langwarrin Football Netball Club.

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators on and off the court.
- Respect the talent, potential and developments of fellow players and competitors.
- Care and respect your uniform and equipment provided by the club.
- Be honest with your coach concerning illness, injury and your ability to train and play at your best.
- Maintain a high standard of personal behavior at all times on and off the court and at club functions (unacceptable behavior may result in suspension from games and functions in extreme cases you may be asked to leave the club)
- Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the umpires. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking rule clarification. (Team Captains may approach umpires at half time if they have any issues or complaints, this must be done in a professional manner)
- Have positive attitude and approach to training sessions and give 100%.
- Cooperate with coaches, netball and football departments in relations to programs that adequately prepare you for competition.
- Participate fairly and safely, showing good sportsmanship.
- Cooperate with your coach and other players at all times.
 - Verbal abuse of officials or other players is not acceptable or permitted.
 - Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
 - Ensure that at all times your behavior is fair
 - Be patient, enthusiastic and encouraging of fellow players.
 - Embrace team selections and play in grade/position as requested by coach
- Applaud all good play by your own team and opponents.
- Respect and acknowledge the contributes of those who create the opportunity for you to play which include volunteers, scorers, coaches, timekeepers, umpires and administrators.
- Refrain from any behavior that will bring the club into disrepute.



- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- Report any grievances promptly to the team coach or Netball President, to be dealt with confidentially using the appropriate procedures.
- Maintain the confidentiality of matters between you as a Club Player and Netball Committee at all times.
- **Do not** use or supply any illegal substances at the club or any club functions.
- Understand the repercussions if you breach the Code of Conduct.

SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

- Social Media should not be used for the posting or exchanging information that has the potential to embarrass or bring the Langwarrin Football Netball Club or its related parties into disrepute.
- Social Media should not be used for communicating confidential or competitively/commercially sensitive information without permission of the Langwarrin Football Netball Club.
- You must use common sense and good judgment - your statements could have an impact on you and the Langwarrin Football Netball Club's reputation. Remember that what you post or publish will become public information.
- If you would not say something to the persons face, do not publish it on any form of social media.
- You are accountable for your actions and what you communicate via social media.
- When posting on any of the Langwarrin Football Netball pages you must not use offensive language or make any negative comments towards anyone.
- Failure to comply with this policy may be the subject of disciplinary action including termination from the Langwarrin Football Netball Club.
